



# Legislative Update

## Current Legislative Session

**Session began on Dec 5, 2022**

Measure introduced: **2,796** in both houses, 959 bills in the Senate and 1,837 bills in the Assembly, about 400 relating to the CA State Budget.

- Deadline to introduce was Feb 17, 2023
- Approximately 1046 were intent bills
- The 2023 total ranked the third highest in the past 20 years
